Here are some great ideas and suggestions to make Family Game Night a night to remember!

### Activities:

- Board games are perfect for a small or large group. If your group is large, think about games that could be played in teams – Apples to Apples®, TRIVIAL PURSUIT, Catch Phrase™, etc. Small-group games could be checkers, dominoes, Uno®, etc.
- Make sure to have games for all of your guests – from the Candy Land® set to the Yahtzee® masters.
- [Learn a new game](#) together. Consider favorite card games like canasta, euchre, gin rummy or 500.
- When playing one-on-one games like checkers or ping-pong, make a winners bracket on a piece of poster board and work your way to a game-night championship.
- Video dance-off games are a fun option for all ages!

### Party Favors:

- Put together a small party favor as a thank-you for guests. Wrap up extra Peanut Butter Brownie Dominoes or Word Play Cupcakes and send home with each guest.
- Make trophies for the first-, second-, and third-place winners of game night. Recycle your old trophies (or find some at thrift stores) by giving them a fresh coat of spray paint. You can also make them by gluing two plastic cups together, bottom to bottom, and coating with paint. Use paper to create small signs with 1st, 2nd or 3rd.



### Tips:

- Old game boards make great serving trays for crackers, cupcakes, etc. To protect the boards from spills, wrap them in plastic wrap before placing the food.
- Background music helps create a fun mood and fills the room as people are contemplating their next game move.
